

## **Parking Restrictions**

Parking in Oxford is at a premium and there is no car parking available at St John's College. Parking is not available at many of the city's hotels and most of the University Colleges. It might be preferable to leave your car at home and travel on public transport or make use of the excellent Oxford park-and-ride-service.

**Park and Ride Service:** 5 car parks are located at each of the main entrances to the city, and bus journeys into the centre are fast and very frequent. The most convenient bus services for St John's College run from Water Eaton (500) and Pear Tree (300) car parks. Parking is permitted for up to 72 hours at Water Eaton and Thornhill car parks. There is no time limit at Pear Tree, Redbridge and Seacourt car parks. The car parks are not manned 24 hours and if you do wish to leave your car overnight, advice should be sought from staff at car parks as the best place to leave a vehicle (all sites are covered by CCTV). Parking charges apply in all Park and Ride car parks.

### **Overnight/Long Stay Car Parking in Oxford:**

Underground car park at Gloucester Green (in central Oxford), a few minutes' walk from St John's College. Open from 7.30am to midnight, seven days a week and it is locked between the hours of midnight and 7.30am, thus preventing access by any person (frequent patrols during the opening hours, and CCTV).

Parking charges range from approximately £3 for the first hour, then on a sliding scale to approximately £36.50 for 24 hours, Sunday to Thursday. Blue badge holders can park for free.
